## Wall of Fame

---

### Policy Statement

The “Wall of Fame’ recognises outstanding performance by enrolled or alumni students of Ballajura Community College.

### Eligibility for induction to the Wall of Fame:

- formerly enrolled at the College;
- have a positive College behaviour record;
- have won an award or title at either state or national level; have been selected for a national team; or
- have been recognised for outstanding achievement by an accredited state or national organisation.

### Considerations

- Students will nominate for one of the four Colours and Honours categories of Academic, Culture, Service and Sport.

### The Induction Process

1. A person can only be inducted once onto the Wall of Fame.
2. Induction will be recognised by a photograph with a citation describing the event that brought about recognition. The student’s name will be added to the Wall of Fame Register, held and maintained by the Colours and Honours Committee.
3. Photographs will remain on the wall in the Performing Arts Centre Foyer for a period not exceeding six years from the date of the induction. After removal from the wall the photographs will be archived with the other College archives in the Main Library.
4. The Colours and Honours Committee will recommend to the Principal the names of the students who meet the criteria for induction. These students, with their achievements, will be showcased in the Ballajura Newsletter.
5. Students will be inducted at a formal function to be held during the last week of Term 4 of each calendar year.
6. Wall of Fame inductees will have their photographs and achievements posted on the College website.

The Colours and Honours Committee will consider nominees for induction, maintain the Wall of Fame, and determine whether a person is eligible for induction. The committee reserves the right to remove an inductee if after induction the person commits an offence that brings the College’s name into disrepute (This can occur at anytime during the six years following induction).
