

# Connecting to the wireless network


1. In the Taskbar at the bottom right of the screen beside date and time, **click** the *Quick Settings* button (it has cluster of battery, network, and volume icon).




2. **Click** the *Arrow Right* button grouped beside the WIFI icon.



3. This opens all available Wi-Fi network list, **Click** the *WIRELESS-5* network.



4. **Click** *Connect* button. (You can also **select** *Connect Automatically* check box).
5. **Type** your **Username (firstname.lastname)** and **password** in the popup authentication box.




6. It will ask to accept to the connection. Simply **Click** *Connect* button.



# Accessing the Internet (Captive Portal)

1. **Open** a *web browser*, for example Edge or Firefox, you should get a screen showing *DoE Captive Portal*. If this does not appear automatically go to <http://sig.site.internal:1000/portal?>
