## DRESS CODE

The Ballajura Community College Dress Code is an important part of the College ethos. Students wearing their uniforms demonstrates our REACH values and pride in our College. The College Board fully endorses the Dress Code and it is very widely supported by the community, students and staff. The Dress Code also serves to ensure the safety of all on the school site by identifying outsiders.

The College requires all students to be in Dress Code at all times. Maintaining acceptable standards of the Dress Code is a requirement of Good Standing at the College. All parents and students are asked to agree to the Dress Code requirements upon enrolment.

All shirts, jumpers and jackets must carry the College logo. Families are strongly encouraged to purchase shorts and pants with the College logo, however, where this is not possible, plain navy blue shorts, pants and skirts are acceptable. Long sleeve shirts worn under school shirts should be navy blue in colour.

There are a variety of styles available from our uniform supplier, Lowes Mirrabooka. Lowes also stock a variety of uniform bottoms that carry the College logo, and we strongly encourage families to purchase these. If this is not possible, plain navy shorts, skirts or pants are acceptable.

Clothing worn as part of the College Dress Code must be an appropriate length and fit, allow for safe and comfortable participation in school activities and demonstrate high standards of presentation.

Casual wear such as hoodies, and active wear such as bike shorts, leggings and gym tights are not part of the College Dress Code. Logos, images, stripes or denim are not permitted.

Hijabs, Kipahs, Turbans and other cultural or religious headwear are acceptable in any appropriate colour or design but should be worn in such a way to be safe when operating machinery etc. The Sword of Imam (Zulfaqar), Christian Crucifix or other such jewellery can be worn but must be tucked into the shirt in sessions where it may be considered a safety issue.

## Footwear

It is important for students to maintain high safety standards for footwear.

Students entering Science laboratories, Technologies including Materials & Construction and Hospitality & Living and The Arts classrooms are required to wear appropriate footwear. In accordance with the State Occupational Health and Safety Standards, footwear must be closed and secured to the foot.

Thongs, slides and sandals are not acceptable.

## Physical Education

Ballajura Community College students are required to purchase a Physical Education shirt. These shirts allow students to proudly support their school houses of Ignis, Aeris, Aqua and Terra.

The shirts are only to be worn during Physical Education classes. Changing shirts for physical education classes is an important part of learning about good hygiene practices and keeping our students healthy.
