COVID-19

You may have heard the Premier announce this morning that from 12.01am on Sunday 14 February. all schools in the Perth and Peel regions will revert back to Phase 4 COVID-19 operating guidelines. in line with all other schools in the State.

With the lifting of the post lockdown restrictions for Peel and Perth, all of our schools will again operate under the same conditions across the State, and students and staff will no longer be required to wear a mask while at school.
