Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to advise that our College remains open for normal operations this week, Tuesday, 27 to Friday 30 April.

You may have seen the WA Government announce the three-day lockdown for Perth and Peel was lifted as of 12.01am on Tuesday, 27 April, and we are now in a post-lockdown transition period until 12.01am on Saturday, 1 May.

Following this latest health advice our school remains open for learning and parents/carers will be able to drop their children at school.

Primary students are not required to wear masks. Secondary students and staff must wear masks while at school. Teachers can remove masks to teach and students and staff can remove their mask while eating and drinking, and during vigorous exercise during PE classes.

We have been informed that for this week, parents/carers are not permitted to attend school functions or activities, such as assemblies, performances, carnivals and year group events.

Parents/carers are reminded that if your child or children are sick with seasonal cold or flu, please keep them at home. This is in line with standard practice and continues to be an important requirement at this time.

The safety of staff and students is a priority and extra cleaning and hygiene measures continue. The latest health information is available through WA Health Department.
