Updated COVID information - This correspondence provides updated information about College operations from Tuesday, June 29 until and including Friday, July 2, 2021

Dear Parents/Carers

You would have heard the Western Australian Government announced last night that Perth and Peel will enter a lockdown effective 12.01am Tuesday, 29 June 2021. At this stage, this will be for a minimum of four days until 12.01am Saturday, 3 July 2021 (commencement of the school holidays).

Currently schools will be open for students, with the exception of Connolly Primary School, Burbridge School and Koondoola Primary School, which remain closed on Tuesday, 29 June.

Masks are required to be worn by all staff and secondary school students at all times while at the College.

Teaching staff are permitted to remove their mask while teaching to help with clear communication and instruction.

Staff and students are permitted to remove their mask while eating and drinking.

Parents are encouraged to ring the College in the first instance for any enquiries you may have. If it is necessary to attend the school site, you may do so provided you:

- wear a mask as per the face covering directions;
- practice 1.5 metres between adults physical distancing, where practical;
- adhere to the 2 square metre per adult venue capacity rule; and
- follow good hand and respiratory hygiene practices.

The Parent Reporting day/night on Wednesday, 30 June will still go ahead as planned, and will be conducted through telephone conversations. Booking times will remain the same and staff will contact parents/carers at these allotted times. Parents/carers are reminded that students do not attend school on this day.

Parents/carers are reminded that if your child or children are sick with seasonal cold or flu, please keep them at home. This is in line with standard practice and continues to be an important requirement at this time.

The safety of staff and students is a priority and extra cleaning and hygiene measures continue. The latest health information is available through WA Health Department.
