Dear Parents/Carers

The WA Government has announce further post-lockdown transition requirements. I am writing to advise you of the updated requirements for schools for next week, Monday May 3 to Friday May 7.

Primary students are not required to wear masks while at school.

Secondary students and staff **must continue to wear masks while at school when they are indoors**. Teachers can remove masks to teach when indoors, and students and staff can remove their mask while eating and drinking if indoors.

Students and staff will not be required to wear masks while outdoors at the College. This includes times during outdoor classes, before and after school, and during recess and lunch times.

College excursions, incursions, events and activities can continue and visitors to these events and activities must follow social distancing and mask wearing requirements.

Parents/carers are permitted to attend the College and must wear masks while indoors.

Parents/carers are reminded that if your child or children are sick with seasonal cold or flu, please keep them at home. This is in line with standard practice and continues to be an important requirement at this time.

The safety of staff and students is a priority and extra cleaning and hygiene measures continue. The latest health information is available through WA Health Department.
